

Devendra Jhajharia wins gold medal at 2016 Rio Paralympics

- India's Devendra Jhajharia (36-year) has won Gold Medal in the men's javelin throw, F46 event at the Rio Paralympics 2016.
- He becomes only the second gold medallist at the Paralympics for the country.
- Earlier, Jhajharia won gold in the javelin event at the 2004 Athens Paralympics.
- He improved his own 2004 record of 62.15 metres with a world-record throw of 63.97 metres.
- Devendra Jhajharia was awarded the Arjuna award in 2004 and the Padma Shri in 2012

Sri Sri Ravi Shankar to be awarded by Jewish rights group




