Verbs followed by Appropriate

1. **Abide by**- पालन करना, मनना
* We must abide by the rules of traffic.
* We must abide by the law.
2. **Abound with**- भरपूर होना
* The honest and generous people abound with blessings of God.
3. **Abound in**- बहुतायत या प्रचुर मात्रा में होना
* Fish abound in this river.
4. **Abstain from**- अलग या बचते रहना, परहेज करना
* I always abstain from alcoholic drinks.
5. **Accede to**- स्वीकार करना, सहमत होना
* I cannot accede to the conditions and terms of this proposal.
6. **Account to a person for a thing**.
* He must account for the money he received, to his manager.
7. **Accuse of**- दोष या अभियोग लगाना
* People accused him of theft/murder.
8. **Accustom to**- आदत डालना, अभ्यस्त होना
* You should accustom yourself to the climate of this area.
9. **Acquaint with**- परिचित होना या पहचान करना
* You must acquaint yourself with the pattern of this exam.
* Let me acquaint you with my father.
10. **Acquit of**- दोष मुक्त करना
* The court has acquitted him of all charges against him.
11. **Adapt to**- स्थिर अनुसार ढालना या अनुकूल बनाना
* You have to adapt yourself to the new circumstances.
12. **Adher to**- जुड़ना या दृढ़ता से साथ लगे रहना
* Mahatma Gandhi adhered to his principle throughout his life.
13. **Agree to**- a proposal सहमत होना

Agree with- a person

- * I don't agree to your proposal.
- * I agree with you on this point.

14. **Apologize to a person for something-** किसी व्यक्ति से किसी

कार्य के लिए क्षमा मांगना

- * I apologize to you for not replying to your letter earlier.
- * He apologized to the manager for his rudeness.

15. **Appeal to someone for/against something-** किसी बात

के लिए या खिलाफ किसी से प्रार्थना करना

- * The poor appealed to the chief minister for financial help.
- * The sky blue shirt appeals to me.

16. **Apply to someone for something-** किसी पद एवं सहायता

आदि हेतु किसी को आवेदन करना

- * The deserving students should apply to the principal for scholarship.

17. **Argue with a person for/against something-** तर्क करना

18. **Argue with a person over/about something-** बहस करना

- * Don't argue with your boss over such a trivial matter.
- * He argued with the bookseller about the price of the book.

19. **Arrive at/in-** पहुंचना / आना

- * He arrived at the station ten minutes late.
- * Our ancestors arrived in this area in 19th century.

20. **Also remember- Arrive at a conclusion/ a decision/ an agreement.**

21. **Ask for/about something from someone-** किसी व्यक्ति से कोई चीज़ मांगना या किसी के बारे में पूछना

- * He asked for his book.
- * He asked me about my parents when he met me.

22. **Assist in/with-** सहायता करना

- * The secretary assisted her boss in his talks with the foreign secretary.
- * She assisted me in this work with her goods suggestions.

23. **Associate with-** किसी से जुड़ना या शामिल होना

- * He should not associate with drug addicts and alcoholics.

24. **Assure someone of something-** किसी को किसी बात के लिए भरोसा देना

- * He assured me of his full support.
- * The employees assured the

manager of their willingness to work hard.

25. Avail oneself of- उपयोग

करना या फायदा उठाना

* The employees should avail themselves of this opportunity for betterment of their families.

26. Bargain with a person for something-

* The unions will bargain with the management for better rates of pay.

27. Beg for something from someone

28. Beg a person to do/not do a thing

* Hundreds of beggars were begging for money from passers-by.

* I beg you not to take any risk.

29. Bestow something on/upon somebody- किसी को उपहार देना या अर्पण करना

* The chancellorship of the university was bestowed upon him in 1999.

* Padam Shree is an honour that is bestowed on the citizens for their great services.

30. Blame someone for something- किसी को किसी कार्य के लिए दोषी ठहराना

* Some people blame others for their failure.

31. Blush at/for/with- सकुचाना, लजाना, झँपना, शरमाना

* Indian women blush at the mention of their husband's name.

* I blushed at my foolish remarks on this lesson.

* The girl blushed with embarrassment when her lover kissed her.

32. Boast of/about- शेखी बघारना

* Some people always boast about their learning.

* He always boasts of his wealth.
